## POOL LEAGUE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Each person pays \$20 for the season to be turned in with the first night's score sheet to either the American Legion or Prime. Following weeks' scores must be text in.
- 2. Two divisions (luck of the draw) play everyone once. The top 5 of each division advance to a round robin. Site to be determined.
- 3. If you have a sub, they will play under your name and count toward your record.
- 4. No coaching from any team members.
- 5. Eight ball straight in. Notify your opponent which pocket you are attempting.
- 6. You must make an honest attempt to hit your object ball. No deliberately shooting the 8 ball if it is not your object ball. Doing so will result in loss of game.
- 7. In the event no ball is made on the break, you can use any ball to make any combination (except 8 ball) to establish stripes or solids without losing your turn.
- 8. The eight ball is not neutral, and jumping balls is not permitted.
- 9. Players must be 21, or accompanied by a parent or guardian
- 10. Start time is 7:00 with a fifteen (15) minute grace period. The line ups are to be turned in to captains before you start.
- 11. Cue ball must be behind the kitchen line. Any ball touching the line is in the kitchen.
- 12. For cue ball fouls only, it is up to the opposing team to decide whether to let the fouler shoot. In the event that another ball gets moved, teams decide either to leave it there or put it back.
- 13. Matches can end in ties.
- 14. To qualify for payout you can only miss 2 weeks of the seasons. Standings will be determined by win percentage.
- 15. Please use first and last names on score sheets.
- 16. The home team will break the first 3 matches, the visiting team will break matches 4-6, and the rest will be determined by coin flip.
